A WORD FROM THE PASTOR

Any Other Answer

"Now it happened that as he was praying alone, the disciples were with him. And he asked them, 'Who do the crowds say that I am?' And they answered, 'John the Baptist. But others say Elijah, and others, that one of the prophets of old has risen" (Luke 9:18-19).

John the Baptist? There's a certain appeal to that claim. John

the Baptist had recently been killed, and a supernatural John would be a fantastic explanation for supernatural acts. So, yeah,

maybe he's John the Baptist.

There is that one slight difficulty that Jesus was on the scene before John was beheaded. Like when John baptized Jesus and saw the Holy Spirit descend on Him in the form of a dove with a voice from heaven saying, "You are My beloved Son; with You I am well-pleased." Or maybe the time John pointed to Jesus and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world." It's kind of hard to get past the It's kind of hard to get past the time when the despondent John, in prison shortly before his death, sent his disciples to Jesus for confirmation. Jesus answered, "Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind receive their sight and the lame walk, lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear, and the dead are raised up, and the poor have good news preached to them." It might not work to say Jesus does miracles because He's a resurrected John when he was doing miracles before John died!

But that's okay, because others had seen the folly of that answer and come up with others—Elijah, or some other prophet that had risen. "Okay—He's not John, but He's still some dead guy!"

There is a grasping at straws in this. Seeking for any answer; any possibility will do. Any **other** answer, that is. Any answer except Jesus.

Obviously, not much has changed in the world. People clearly will accept almost any explanation for things, so long as it doesn't include God, or the Son of

God. Salvation? No. Reincarnation? You bet! Creation? No. Man evolving from moss? Sure! One way to heaven? How narrow-minded! All religions are the same (in spite of their obvious differences)? Of course!

You grasp at straws when you're drowning and you need something to help you stay afloat. How foolish to grasp at straws when all you have to do is stand on the rock that is right there. But people don't like the Rock; so they look for anything else.

Jesus wasn't finished with this conversation, though. "But who do you say that I am?" He asked. "And Peter answered, 'The Christ of God." The crowds didn't understand, but Jesus' followers did.

Responding to this statement of faith—of recognition—Jesus gave His disciples some further teaching. He was about to be rejected, killed, and to rise on the third day.

This is something that only makes sense to people who recognize who He is. For those who accept any other answer, it is just more religious babble. For we who know who He is, it is the message of our salvation.


