Hello from our new place in Mbouda!
Dear Friends and Family,

We have now moved into our apartment in a monastery in the West Region of Cameroon and are very happy here. We are in an upstairs apartment of a two-story building and we are renting most of the floor.

In January, the translators came three times to our house to work on the translation with Cam. When Dr. Mfonyam, a consultant, came they were able to consultant check the book of Titus. It is wonderful that the translators are able to come and continue their work here together. They have been drafting most of the epistles on their own for the last three years, and now they can have more input and encouragement from others.

During the month of February, the translators were unable to come due to restrictions on travel in the North West so it was pretty quiet. At the end of February, the Bafanji translators came with Dr. Mfonyam again and got started checking 1 Timothy. It is wonderful to have more consultant help and make some progress toward finally publishing. While they were still here, our team leaders, Dan and Melody Grove, were able to come and stay at our house. This has brought even more Ndop Plain visitors, including the team of six Ndop Plain men set last year to be the new leaders for the Ndop Plain translation project. We feel so blessed to be living near the work and able to provide food and housing to help the work go ahead.

Plans are moving ahead! In an effort to avoid having to put in a fire suppression sprinkler system (\$50,000 +/-), we have reduced the length of the Fellowship Hall. The kitchen, bathrooms, storage and classrooms are the same size, but the open area will now be 50’ long, instead of the original 80. This will be big enough for a full-sized Awana game floor, and should meet all our needs.

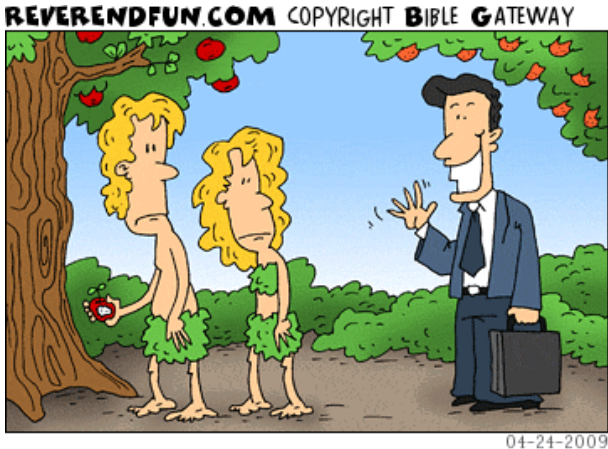
