A WORD FROM THE PASTOR

For Your Convenience...

Labor Day, Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Memorial Day, Presidents' Day, Maybe there are some others. These are holidays that have been moved to Monday for your convenience. They are big enough to warrant a day off, but not so big they can't be moved.

Some days won't be moved: Groundhog Day, Valentines Day

(sorry, you romantics out there), and Flag Day fall in this category. Even though they are recognized as special days, they do not warrant a day off, so they are safe from calendar-juggling

Then there are the Big Boys. These are the days that can hold their own and just dare you to move them. Easter is a special category, being the king of Sunday holidays. Mother's Day and Father's Day are other dedicated Sunday holidays. They will never be moved from that first day position. Christmas and Thanksgiving bring several leisure days with them, so even those who disrespect them have nothing to gain by moving them.

Another special category, and the inspiration for this article, is the holiday known by its date. You can't move New Year's Day. It just is where it is. For some reason, our Independence Day is known as the Fourth of July instead of Independence Day. It would be mobile if not for that, but that is that, so it will stay. Besides, officially or not, the 4th of July also carries leisure days with it, so we don't mind. This whole rescheduling of things for our convenience, though, is a problem. It helps create the illusion that we are actually in control of what happens and when it happens in our lives.

Tucked away in the middle of Proverbs is this insightful verse: "The heart of a man plans his way, but the LORD establishes his steps." We plan what we think we're going

to do, God takes it from there. And if you've ever noticed, sometimes where He takes it from there is inconvenient. Reality interferes with those plans you've made. God is not apologetic about that. He simply knows who is in control and who is not.

For instance, He knows the day of our death, and we do not. Psalm 90 tells us simply, "The years of our life are seventy, or even by reason of strength eighty..." Yet while that gives us a reasonable range of expectation, its nothing like a hard and fast rule. But God, on the other hand, knows the exact date of departure each of us has stamped on his ticket. "In your book were written, everyone of them, the days that were formed for me, when as yet there was none of them" (Ps 139:16).

Days that work out the way you want are really nice; and I hope you have several of them this summer; the 4th being one of them. But God did not design this life to be convenient. He has better things in mind for us. Things we often find inconvenient. When that happens, count it all joy, and have a great summer.
