
New Years and End Times

The announcer reads the category: "The most common question asked of the driver."" All contestants frantically slam their buzzers, but only one wins. He immediately gives the number one answer, "Are we there yet?" (Less popular answers are: "Are we lost?' "Can we change the station?" and "Do you have a rag?")

Maybe God gets tired of us asking too, but we're kids on a ride, we know we're going somewhere, and we're anxious to get there. God is the driver, and only He knows the answer. We want to know; are we there yet?

Often we approach the End Times questioning what they will be like. We want to know what will happen, when it will happen, in what order; and most important, will we be there to see them happen? To answer these questions we produce charts and timelines, and then argue with people about the differences in our charts and timelines. I don't discourage this; God put this information in the Bible, and it is right for us to study it.

A skeleton framework of events goes something like this: A world-leading figure will arise and establish a seven-year peace treaty with Israel. It will be a time of famine and plague. Halfway through the seven years, he will break the treaty, demand worship, and establish the 'Mark of the Beast.' At the end of the seven years, Jesus will return and establish the Millennium—the thousand year reign of Christ. Somewhere in this is the rapture; either just before the peace treaty, at the half-way point, or coin-



All your charts and timelines will work around this framework. Keep it in mind when you do your studies.

As we look at recent world events, things seem to be accelerating toward the end. We know we're getting closer, and we want to know if we're there yet. But if we look at what accompanies end times teaching in the Bible; we find there is more purpose than just knowing what will happen.

Matthew 25 follows with a parable about faithless servants and teaches us about taking care of the least of these, our brethren. Second Thessalonians 2 contains a warning about being deceived by false signs, and is followed by gratitude for God's salvation. Hebrews 10:23-25 tells us to stimulate each other to love and good deeds, and 'not forsake our gathering together,' 'and all the more as you see the day approaching.'

Jesus tells us to watch so the day will not take us by surprise; so let's watch. But let's not watch as children just waiting to get there. Let's watch as servants preparing for their Master's return.




